2. Show children with cancer and their families that they are not alone in their fight against cancer.
3. Tell children with cancer that it is OK to be bald.
4. Raise funds to help children with cancer and their families.
5. Build a community of support for children with cancer and their families.

Every shaven head represents an understanding by an individual of the ordeals that a child with cancer is subjected to. HfH provides an opportunity to garner support from the public in the form of monetary pledging. By volunteering to shave, the shavees become Children's Cancer Foundation's (CCF) ambassadors in spreading childhood cancer messages to their family and peers while garnering monetary support from them. The funds raised will contribute to the overall annual \$5 million needed to provide financial and support services to help our children with cancer and their families to cope at different stages of the illness.
