Paper 1 – Writing (Duration – 50 min)	12 marks (7.5%)
Paper 2 – Language Use (Duration – 1 hour)	40 marks (25%)
Paper 3 – Listening Comprehension	12 marks (7.5%)
Paper 4 – Oral (Reading aloud, Stimulus- based conversation)	16 marks (10%)
	80 marks (50%)



PEDAGOGY – P2 MATHEMATICS

Concrete – **manipulatives, measuring tools, or other objects** the pupils can handle during the lesson.

Pictorial – **drawing, diagrams, charts, or graphs** that are drawn by the students or are provided for the students to read and interpret.

Abstract – representations such as **numbers or letters** that the student writes or interprets to demonstrate understanding of a task.

Key Focus

- To develop pupils' communication skills through spoken and written interaction



P2 Mother Tongue Languages

To develop pupils' language proficiency based on the following skills

Listening	Picture matching, understand simple text, instructions, spelling
Speaking	Picture Description, Show & Tell
Reading	Reading of words, sentences, text, Big Books
Writing	Language Use (Grammar, vocabulary, comprehension-CL&ML), Journal Writing
Interaction	Spoken Interaction Written Interaction



Initiatives to promote active MTL Users

Reading Culture

- Instill the love of reading MTL books through a structured reading programme to enrich learning.

MTL Enrichment Programmes

- Organized MTL events such as MTL Fortnight, Cultural Camp and other enrichment activities to promote learning and use of MTL beyond classroom.
- To build up students' self-esteem and confidence in speaking in the Mother Tongue Language (Term 1)

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GUIDELINES FOR LEARNING TIME

Learning Time - both written and non-written homework

Rationale -

- **Cultivate the good habit of self study and initiative**
 - **Promote thinking skills**
 - **Reinforce learning**
 - **Lesson preparation**

SA Revisions	<u>Maximum 1.5 hours</u> 30 mins for Mother Tongue 1 h for English and Maths <i>*Practice papers will be done in class.</i>
School holidays (Mar, Jun and Sep holidays)*	Mar holidays No homework
	Jun & Sep – 1 week or 10 hours worth of homework
Festive seasons (CNY , Hari Raya Puasa, Hari Raya Haji, Deepavali)*	Strictly no homework to be given

****Any other school holidays or festive holidays, such as Youth Day, Vesak Day, Labour Day etc., it is up to the discretion of the teachers to decide if learning time is necessary.***



Examination Matters

In the event that your child is absent for any examination, an official medical certificate is required.



SOP

- Absence from school must be accompanied by a medical certificate or excuse letter.
- Absences and late-coming are closely monitored. (Advisory letter will be issued)
- Parents are to report to General Office and make a request in the event child needs to leave school early. To keep FT informed.
