Dear Parents / Guardians,

Re: Primary 3 School-Based Assessments for Semester 1 2023

Since 2019, schools had removed all examinations, including weighted assessments (WAs), for Primary 1 and 2. This has allowed the students to place more focus on *learning* and strengthen their 21st century competencies (21CC) while reducing the excessive focus on *testing*. We have seen positive impact over the years where students shared that they had more time to learn, explore and pursue their passions.

The school will continue to build on these gains and remove the mid year examinations for Primary 3 to 6 this year. To monitor the students' learning, our teachers will be using a variety of teaching and assessment approaches such as classroom observations, individual work, homework and WAs. It is important that students put aside time daily to revise the lessons taught and complete their homework on time. This will allow the teachers to give them feedback regarding their progress in a more timely manner.

The details of the WAs (semester 1) for Primary 3 students are attached in <u>Annex A</u>. The weightings for each WA in terms 1 to 3 will be 10% and 70% for the end of year examination. We will send you the details of WA and end of year examination schedule for semester 2 in July. Please note that there is no make-up for all WAs should students be absent. Do refer to page 11 of the Student's Diary for more details on our Assessment Policy for Absenteeism.

We look forward to your partnership in providing a meaningful learning experience for your child. Should you require further clarification, please contact your child's/ward's form/subject teachers.
