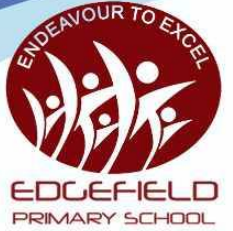

not on mistakes

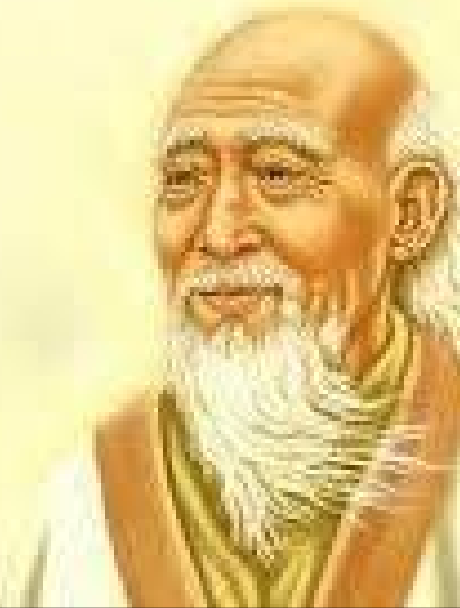
Praise efforts and
