Dear Parents/Guardians,

**Re: Primary 4 School-Based Assessment for Term 1 2025**

The removal of Mid-Year Examinations has allowed students to have more opportunities to strengthen their 21<sup>st</sup> century competencies (21CC) while reducing the overemphasis on examinations and grades. We have seen a positive impact over the course of time where students shared that they had more time to learn, explore and participate in engaging learning experiences.

To monitor students' learning, our teachers will be using a variety of teaching and assessment approaches such as classroom observations, individual work, homework and Weighted Assessments (WAs). It is important that students put aside time daily to revise the lessons taught and complete their homework on time. This will allow teachers to give them feedback on their learning progress in a timely manner.

The assessment weightings for the P4 WAs in Terms 1, 2, and 3 and End-of-Year Examination (EYE) in Term 4 are shown in the table below:
